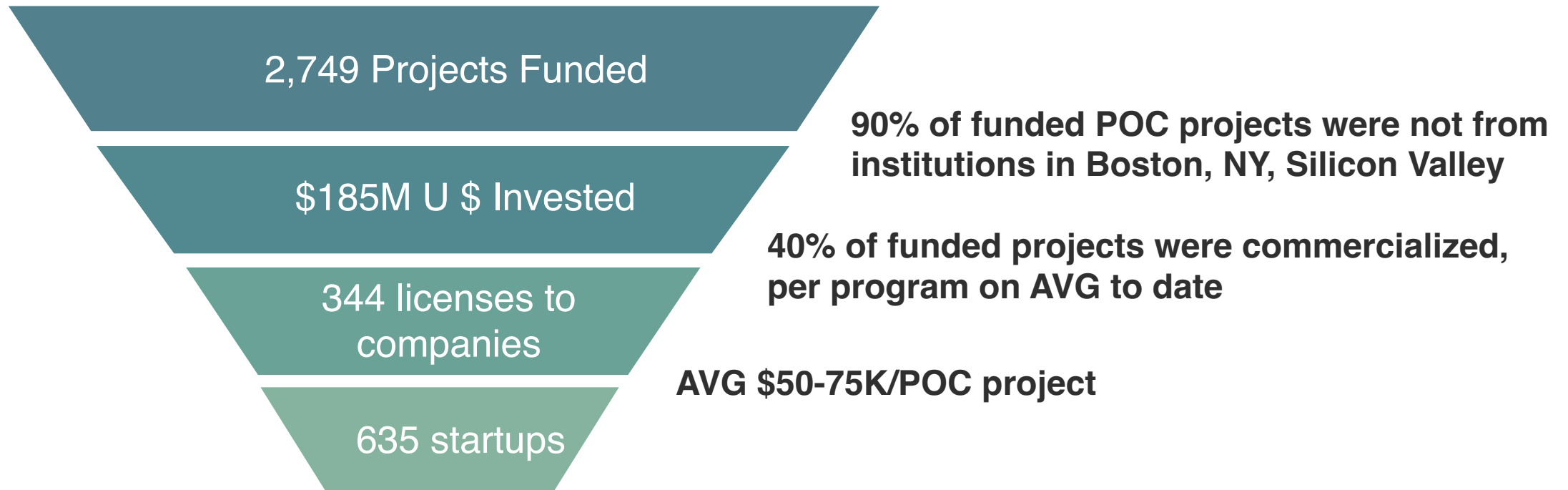

2005

Launched Mind the Gap Initiative

Conducted the first, global analysis of university proof of concept, startup and venture gap funds and accelerators. Now includes participation from 141 programs from 86 universities

2015

Launched Pardon the Disruption

Developed and delivered a process to connect companies to research institution tech and startup assets

2018

Launched GAP Community of Action/COVERGENCE

Founded a community of practice for active university fund managers (now with 35 member universities) and COVERGENCE, an annual summit attended by 75 university GAP programs, corporate innovation, and investors

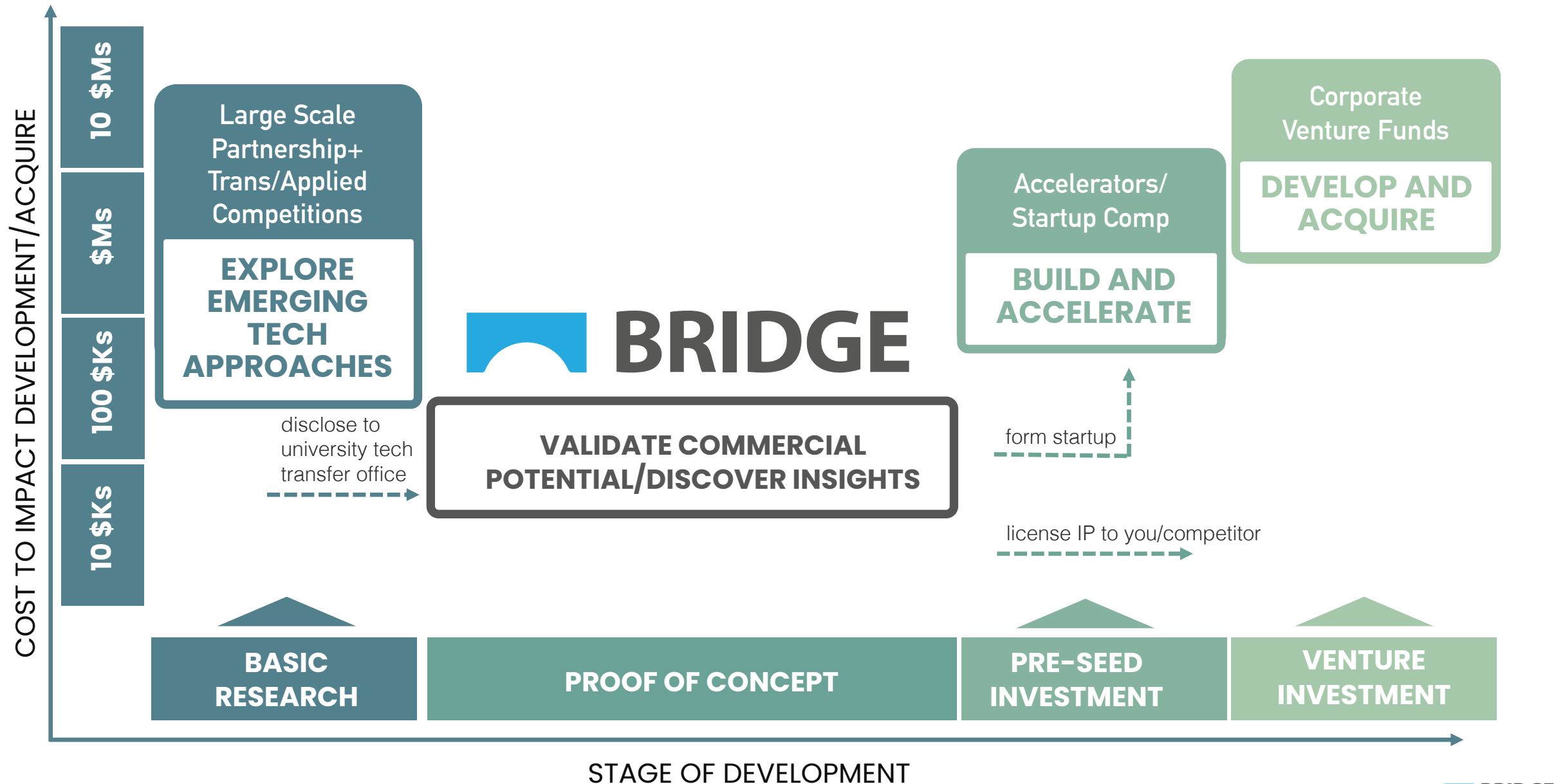

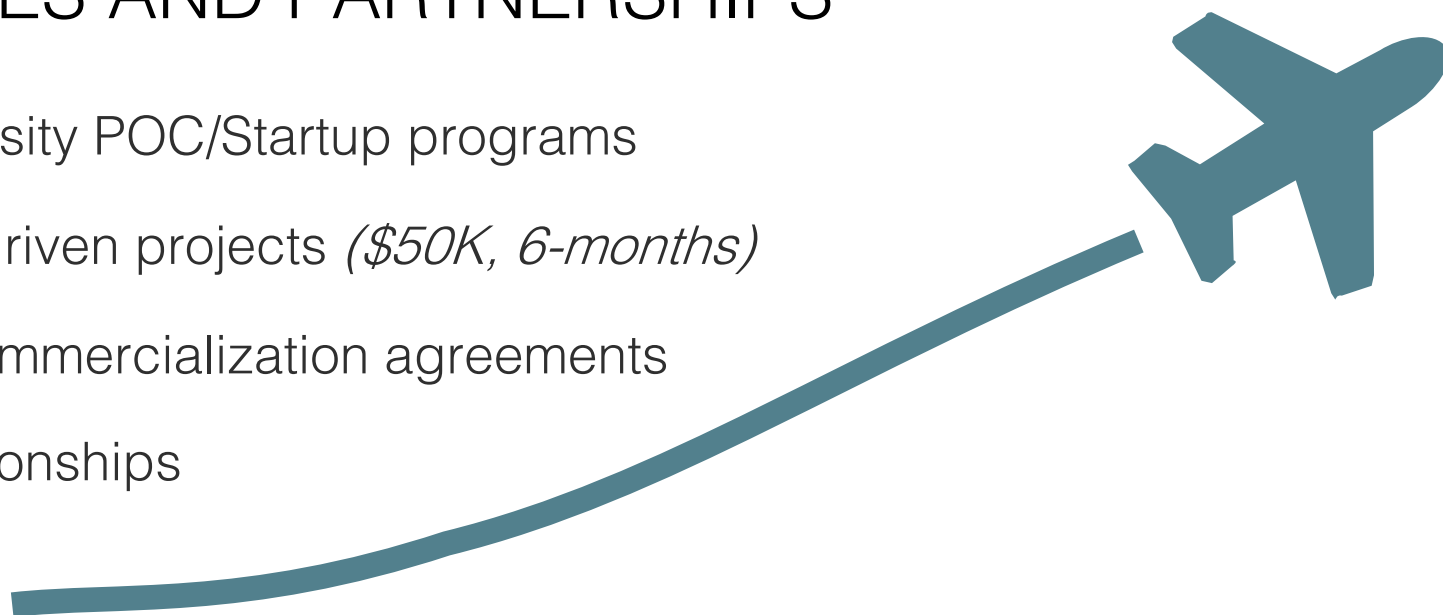

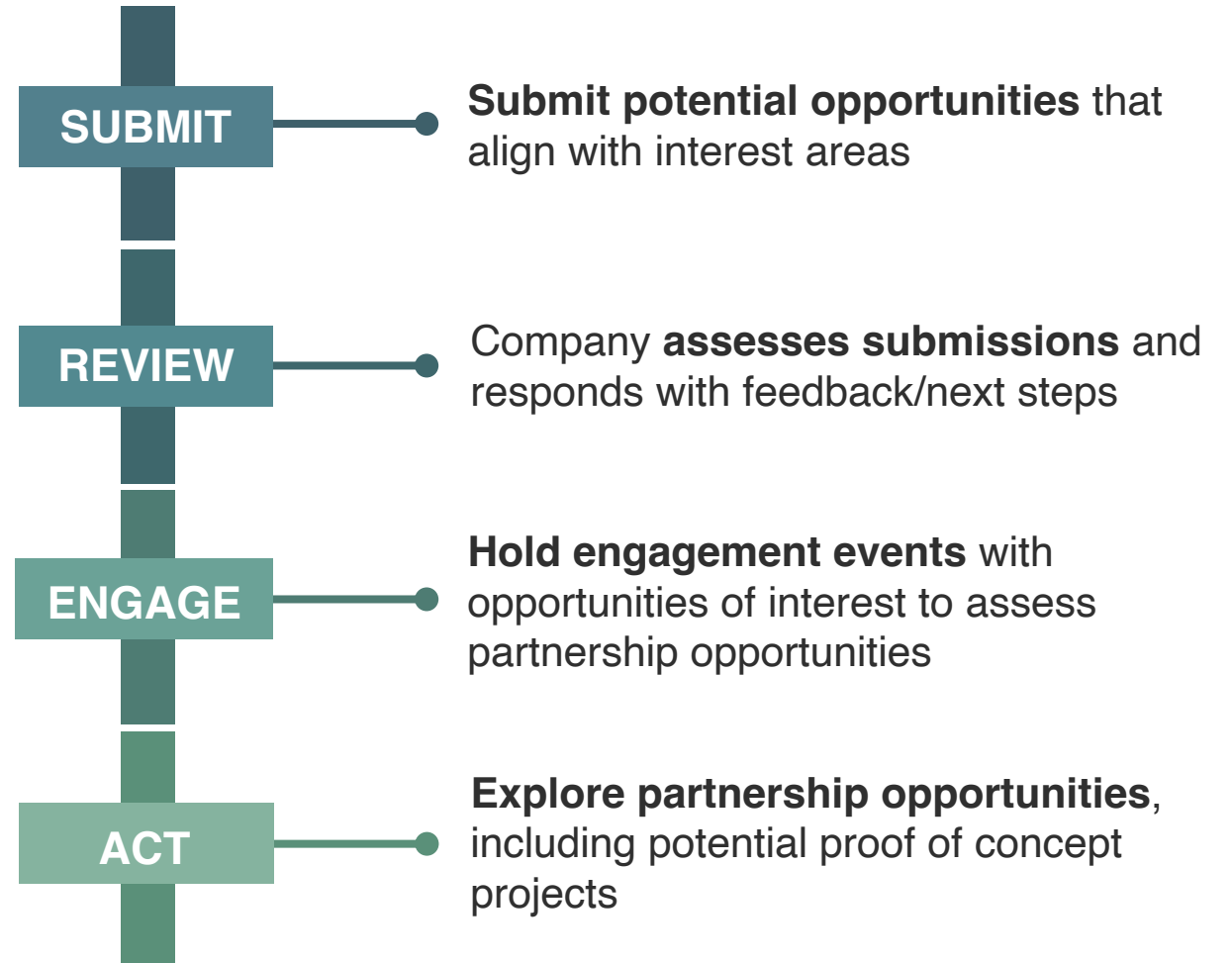
A CORPORATE-DRIVEN PROOF OF CONCEPT PROGRAM TO IDENTIFY AND ENGAGE UNIVERSITY TECH AND STARTUP OPPORTUNITIES AND PARTNERSHIPS

- Complimentary to existing university POC/Startup programs
- Short-term validation/milestone-driven projects (*\$50K, 6-months*)
- De-risk (and ideally expedite) commercialization agreements
- Initiate and forge long-term relationships

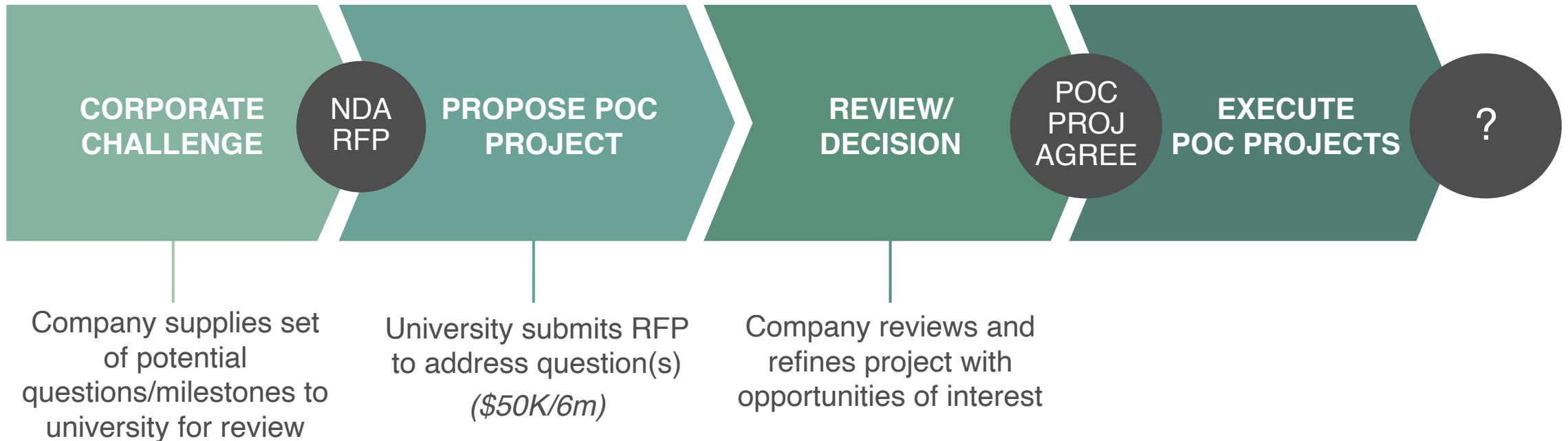

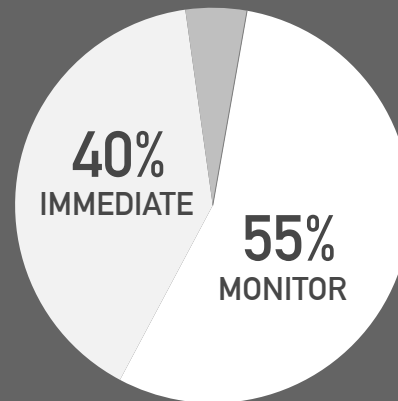

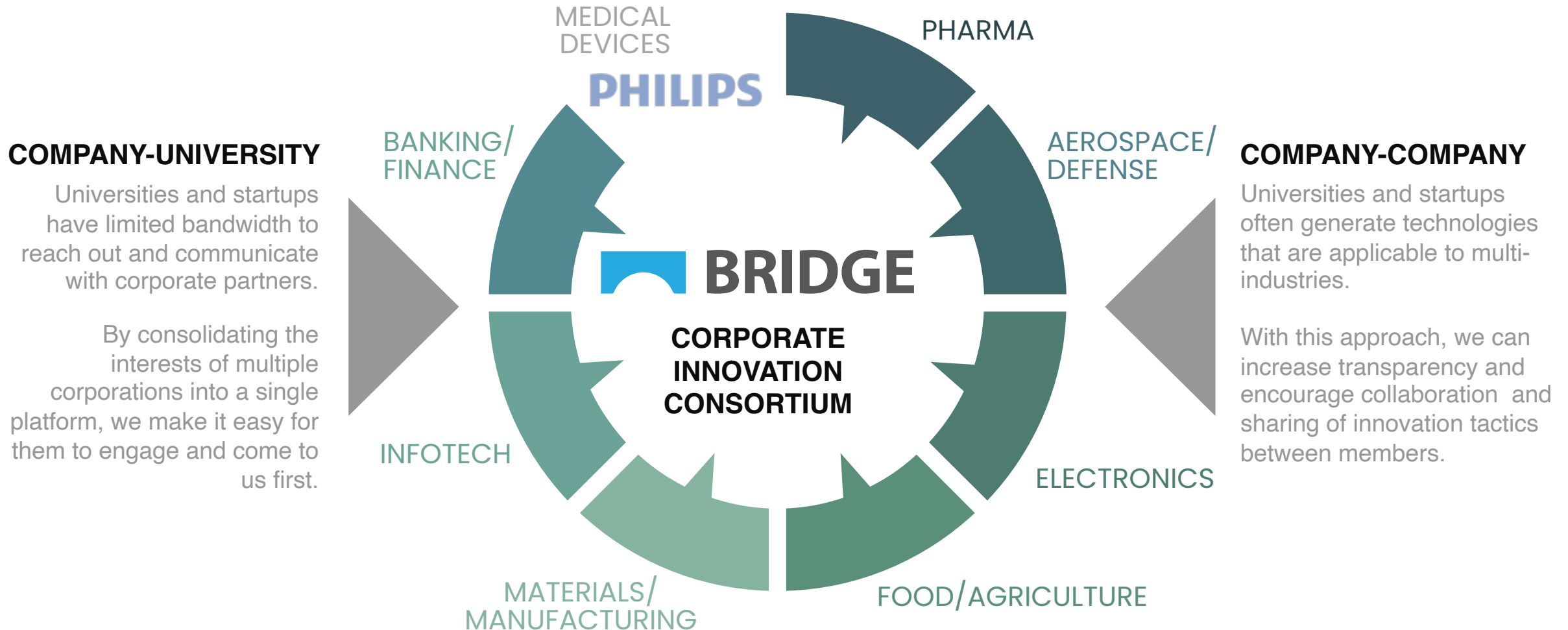
